



VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

LEAD TESTING OF PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL WATER SERVICES

Under Ontario Regulation 170/03, Schedule 15.1, all large municipal residential water Systems such as the Town of LaSalle must have 60 private residences tested for lead in the water.

This testing must take place between December 2007 and April 2008 and every subsequent 6 month period.

This testing in homes will take place at a point where water is used for human consumption (for example: kitchen tap) and will take approximately 35 minutes. The Town of LaSalle is seeking volunteers for this testing in homes where lead soldered copper pipes (prior to 1993) or lead water services (prior to 1950) were used.
